FOREWORD

I accepted Christ on January 19, 1989. I had little or no knowledge of what this actually meant; but I began to read the Bible daily, starting with the Book of John, asking God for understanding.

I received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit on May 12, 1989. It was then I began rereading John with my daughters, Jaime and Jennie. Much to my delight I received understanding and, in time, so did they.

That fall I helped a member of my church start a clown ministry. On Thanksgiving Day I asked the Lord for poetry verses of a Biblical nature to improve Mother Goose nursery rhymes.

I went to the library and took out two Mother Goose books which included over 450 rhymes. I solved the problems in eighty-four poems by way of short stories which had morals taken from scriptures in the New King James Bible. I mistakenly assumed these poems were for the use of the clown ministry but it was short-lived.

I then made these eighty-four poems into twelve little books and was compelled to have them copyrighted on Christmas Day for Jesus.

Mother Goose verses were not originally intended for children, but were a form of political satire. This explains their cruelty and insensitivity. When I read about a man jumping into a bramble bush and, "...scratched out both his eyes," I could not bring myself to work with it. The illustration merely showed a man jumping into the bush, leaving the rest to your imagination, and I wondered how long it would be till someone drew the actual outcome of the scene.

Readers who share my feelings about Mother Goose rhymes as orginally written will welcome finding that some of its most famous characters have had their daily problems solved with the Lord's guidance. It is my hope that the young-at-heart in reading these verses will also be drawn to seek the Lord for their salvation.

Although not a Mother Goose rhyme, the first four lines of "Each Time I Awake" came to me as I was waking up one day. I went back to sleep saying, "That's nice," twice before I told the Lord, "Okay, okay, I'll write it down." This introductory poem is a testimony to Him from Whom this gift of words came.

The beginning of "I Live My Life for Thee" was written to my mom, Marianne Keil-Farinella, by my dad, Joseph C. Farinella, in the early years of their marriage. It is included in memory of my mom who accepted Christ only days before her death.

The first verses of "Forgive the World" were also written by Dad and completed by the author. This poem is included in honor of my earthly father and in memory of my grandmother, "Lucia" Farinella, and my father-in-law, "Mister" James R. Fritsch Sr.

The entire book follows one central thought which is expressed by "The Son of Man" poem. Jesus Christ died to open the way for all mankind into heaven. His Holy Spirit, if yielded to, will help us to achieve those things we were created to perform.

My children and I are looking forward to the reading of the Book of Life and the beginning of the New Jerusalem. Until then I must do the things the Lord has laid before me in an effort to spread His Word and shine His Light of Truth.

Said the good Lord, To all of man, "Remember Him, If you all can."



The dinner was set, But the guests didn't come; What was made for many, Was saved for some.


The feast was on hold, And the food was frozen; *"For many are called, But few are chosen."


There was a little boy, Went into a barn, And lay down On some hay;

I sing, I sing, From morn till night; From cares I'm free, And my heart is light.


*I sing a new song, To You, O God; Though people see me, As if I'm odd.

"And besides they learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house, and not only idle but also gossips and busybodies, saying things which they ought not."


Patience is a virtue, Virtue is a grace; Both put together, Make a very pretty face.




